Buffalo, MN June 13, 2023—The City of Buffalo has been named one of the **Top Workplaces in Minnesota** by the Star Tribune. Produced by the same team that compiles the 32-year-old Star Tribune 100 report of the best-performing public companies in Minnesota, Top Workplaces recognizes the most progressive companies in Minnesota based on employee opinions measuring engagement, organizational health, and satisfaction. The analysis included responses from 124,719 employees at Minnesota public, private and nonprofit organizations.

The results of the Star Tribune Top Workplaces are based on survey information collected by Engage, an independent company specializing in employee engagement and retention.

The City of Buffalo currently employees 96 full time employees and 97 part-time and seasonal employees across 15 departments.

To qualify for the Star Tribune Top Workplaces, a company must have more than 50 employees in Minnesota. Over 5,000 companies were invited to participate. Rankings were composite scores calculated purely on the basis of employee responses.
