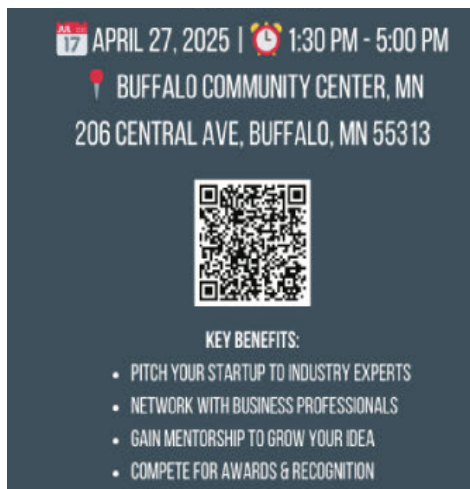

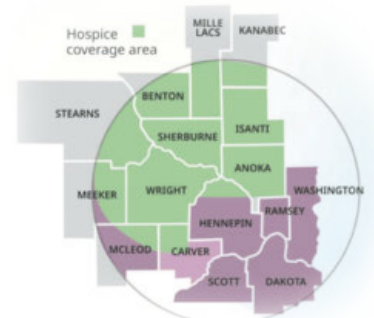

As a part of the national organization ITNAmerica, YOU-Hoot will operate in the Buffalo area as part of our local response to the increasing public need for senior transportation services. We are beginning recruitment of volunteer drivers for this new community service. Volunteer drivers will set their schedule and driving distance limits. We will begin service by scheduling ride appointments to and from the Buffalo Community Center and some medical appointments. YOU-Hoot will expand as needs grow, especially at the upcoming new "Pen-Rad" location of the Community Center, and as more volunteers become available to serve. This service will operate in addition to already robust public transportation systems in the community, to help expand hours and coverage. Riders will pay a small fee that will be used to pay for the operating costs of software and staff. If you already attend some of our special events and have reliable transportation, or just simply enjoy helping those in need, then being a YOU-Hoot driver could be right for you. 
