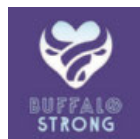

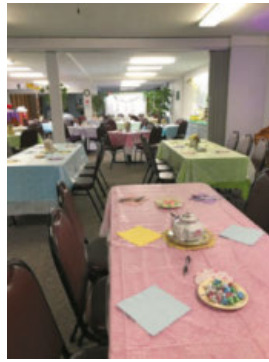



Beat well. 2 C. flour, 1 tsp. baking soda, ½ tsp. baking powder, ½ tsp. cinnamon, ½ tsp. salt, ¼ tsp. nutmeg, ¼ tsp. allspice, Fold in ½ c. pecans. Put into well greased 9x5x3 loaf pan. Combine ¼ c. chopped pecans, ½ c. brown sugar, ¼ tsp. cinnamon. Mix well and sprinkle over batter in pan, pressing down lightly. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour until done. Cool on rack.
