



Millie's Pumpkin Bars (An alternative to pie)


4 eggs	2 C. sugar (1 brown & 1 white)	
2 C. pumpkin	1 C. salad oil	½ tsp. salt
2 tsp. cinnamon	2 tsp. baking powder	
1 tsp. baking soda	2 C. flour	½ C. nuts (optional)
