

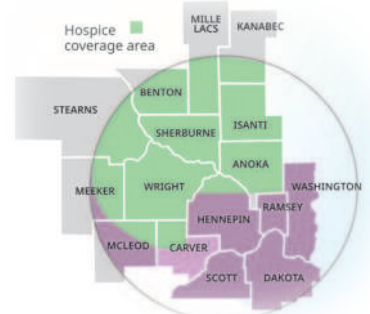

Sift together the following: 4 C. plus 4 heaping Tb. Flour, ½ tsp. salt, 1 tsp. soda and 1 tsp. cream of tartar, Mix wet and dry ingredients together.
Dough will be soft and pliable. Roll dough to size of walnuts. Press down on an UNGREASED cookie sheet with the bottom of a glass that has been dipped in sugar.

Bake at 350 for 10 minutes.
