



2021 Community Gardens City of Buffalo

The City of Buffalo will be taking reservations for community gardens. The garden site is located at **Gary Mattson Park**. Gary Mattson Park is located off CSAH 35 on the NW corner of Buffalo Lake.

Individual garden plots are approximately 10' x 20'. The garden area is measured with string marking the perimeter of each plot. There is a 5-foot walkway down the center of the garden site. Water is available by hose at one end of the garden.

If you would like to reserve a garden space, fill out the form below and mail it with your check to Buffalo Community Gardens, City of Buffalo, 212 Central Ave., Buffalo MN 55313. (You may reserve no more than 2 plots per household. In the event of a large number of requests, gardeners may be limited to one spot each.) Plots will be assigned in late April, with gardeners contacted via email with plot maps and information.

DOGS AND OTHER FAMILY PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE GARDENS. Please be respectful of park users and neighboring gardeners. Do your best to keep gardens looking nice and weed free. Garden privileges will be revoked for those that fail to maintain them.

Gardens will be tilled and ready to plant by **May 1st**, weather permitting (additional ground preparation may be needed before planting). Gardeners must clear their plots of stakes and plant debris by **October 10th**. Plant debris can be taken to the City's compost site located behind the Civic Center at 1306 County Road 134. Debris should not be left at the garden site.
