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Overview

This summer, the City of Buffalo is completing a street maintenance project to improve and extend the life of streets in several areas.

The improvements will consist of a bituminous overlay providing a new driving surface on the roadway. All improvements are paid for through the City of Buffalo's General fund and not subject to special assessments.



Project Schedule

The Contractor has submitted a project schedule summarized below:

Buffalo Run, Willow Creek Court, and Orr Ave Areas:

- Curb and Gutter Spot Repairs – July 20 – July 24
- Storm Sewer Orr Ave – July 20 – July 22
- Manhole Adjustments throughout project – July 21 – July 24
- Mill and Bituminous Overlay Streets – July 27 – July 31

Calder Avenue

- Set up Detour – August 3
- Street, Utility, and Concrete Work – August 4 – August 21
- Remove Detour – August 21



Project Details

In addition to the bituminous milling and overlay of streets, miscellaneous repairs such as spot curb replacement, manhole adjustments, and storm sewer on Orr Ave. will be completed. At the intersection of Pulaski Road and Calder Ave. a RRFB flashing crosswalk beacon will be installed to improve pedestrian safety at the crosswalk. Additionally, this intersection will be reconfigured with designated left turn lanes on Calder Ave.



Calder Avenue will be closed from CSAH 35 (roundabout) to Pulaski Road. The intersection of Pulaski Road will remain open. A detour route as shown on the attached map will be posted. The portion of the project north of Pulaski Road will be completed under traffic with lane closures and flaggers. The detour is anticipated to be in place for approximately 3 weeks.

Access to properties within the rest of the project areas will be maintained throughout the majority of the project. If any spot curb and gutter repairs are required in front of your driveway (it will be marked with paint if it is being replaced), you will not be able to drive over the new curb and gutter for a period of 7 days to allow the concrete to fully cure. If spot curb and gutter repairs affect access into your driveway, you will be contacted by the contractor in the field prior to the new curb being constructed.



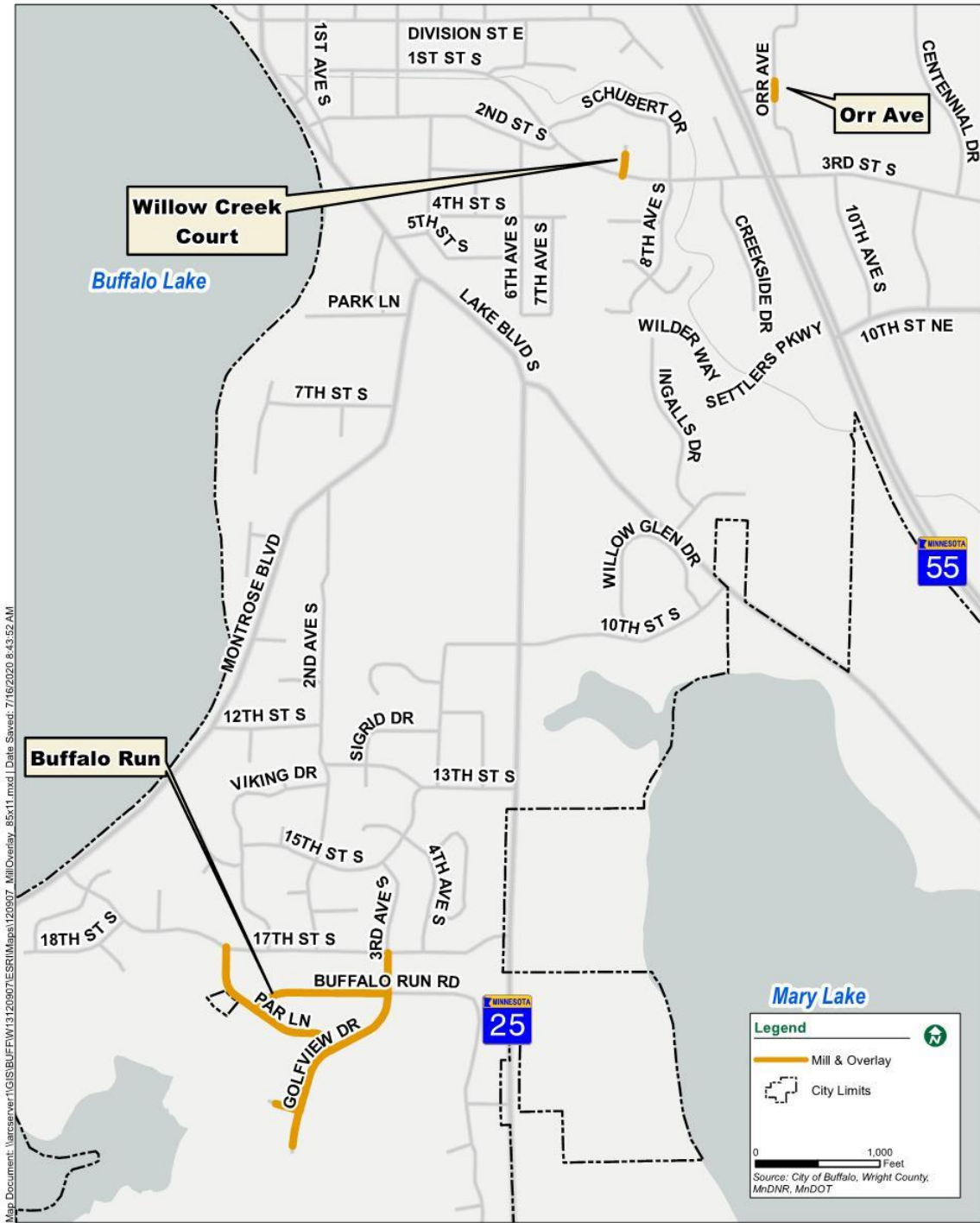
